C. New Business

- a. Discuss/Take action Council will decide if a Memorial bench or tree to be placed within the City Limits, in memory of the four Community ISD students, who were in a terrible accident, November 2019. This was tabled on January 14, 2020 meeting, for Travis Waddell to speak with Dr. Nivens.
- b. Discuss/Take Action Storage at City Hall is limited. The City Secretary, Judy Hill, would like to address the Council with solutions.
- c. Discuss/Take Action Crystal with CWC Creations, is planning a fun for the family type gathering, on Saturday, April 11, 2020. There will be Coffee, crafts & furniture of course. C&C Creations will also host an Easter egg hunt & bounce houses for the kiddos, all types of vendor booths, music, raffles & food trucks, for when you get hungry.
