Jim Shepherd stated that the Children at Play signs are fine, but the speed deterrents are dangerous, and a liability to the City. Chief Jones stated in prior meeting that the study did not warrant for speed deterrents. Gwen Garlington, is not for the speed deterrents, but would like to check into Children at Play sign cost.

# The following was sent to Lavon PD for consideration.

The City of Nevada would like to continue the ILA with a contract price derived from the following: \$90,000.00 which would be the equivalent to an officer's salary, insurance, benefits, and other related expenses etc. \$8,000.00 as an additional contribution towards maintenance and operations at a fair market value. Along with all of the provisions of the existing ILA, City of Nevada would like to reiterate that LPD shall maintain records of responses to emergency calls, including, but not limited to: date, time, location, type of call and time of response, and related results. Lavon agrees to provide a report for each month, with the report being provided by the 15th day of the following month containing the foregoing information regarding police services arising in. We know that more than one officer is involved in serving Nevada. The proposal above is simply to suggest how the costs incurred by LPD for services provided can be viewed in a different way, rather than a percentage of the entire LPD budget. Many of those costs are fixed and would not change whether Nevada is being patrolled, or not.

# 5. Discuss/Take Action:

a. TXDOT Speed study, FM 6. (Mayor Kinnard) The Council is in favor of the speed study that lowers the speed throughout FM 6, but not the increase towards North 1138. City Secretary will contact TXDOT, to see if the change to increase can be changed. Shane Brinton makes a motion to accept the speed study from TXDOT to lower the speed through town on FM 6, but wants to keep the same speed instead of an increase going towards North FM 1138.
